### MPN Newcastle Middle and Secondary Schools' Offer

Middle and secondary Schools who buy into services from MPN Newcastle also gain access to a number of ensembles, and are regularly signposted to activities available through partner organisations, such as Sage Gateshead. Currently, MPN Newcastle funds and supports the following opportunities:

- Gosforth Academy Boys Choir
- Weekly ukulele, woodwind, recorder, brass and ceilidh band ensembles
- Access to NTMEH (North Tyneside Music Education Hub) weekly ensembles at the Langdale Centre.



All middle and secondary schools in Newcastle who fulfil the conditions of the ACE grant and provide annual feedback / data to MPN Newcastle also receive a financial allocation each year to support musical progression. Many middle and secondary schools use this allocation to subsidise a programme of instrumental and singing tuition or to provide instrumental / vocal tuition / ensemble support delivered by one of MPN Newcastle's team of visiting tutors.

In order to support middle and secondary schools in developing a singing strategy, MPN Newcastle also facilitates termly gifted and talented singing days open to students in Year 9 and above and signposts students to participation in other region-wide choral opportunities, including Swing Bridge Singers, Quay Voices, NTMEH Youth Choir and Newcastle Cathedral Choir. MPN Newcastle also offers access to a boys' choir held at Gosforth Academy.



### **Extension Support to Middle and Secondary Schools**

In addition to core support, MPN Newcastle offers and supports a variety of CPD opportunities to middle and secondary schools who buy into MPN Newcastle's services. CPD is specifically focused around strengthening and improving the KS3-5 music curriculum. In addition to termly network meetings, recent CPD has included:

- Music Technology Training (Creating Virtual Performances / streaming on YouTube / using Soundtrap in the classroom)
- Composing at Key Stage 4
- GCSE Coursework Standardising sessions for AQA and Edexcel examination boards.
- Supporting gifted and talented singers at Key Stage 4



A bespoke lesson observation service is also available to schools on request to ensure quality of instrumental and vocal tuition and planning of relevant CPD for visiting music teachers. The observation cycle in 2019-20 supported the development of CPD for instrumental tutors working in Newcastle schools, focusing on quality of teaching and use of ICT to support outcomes, with training on using *Seesaw* as an assessment tool.

Middle and secondary schools can also access MPN Newcastle's (chargeable) instrument loan service. Instruments are kept centrally, and can be used for one-off projects, on-going projects or for students having instrumental lessons.

MPN Newcastle also provides access to large scale music experiences for middle and secondary aged students. Recent examples of these include:

- Rock School events at o2 academy (12 schools over 2 nights in 2020)
- o2 Academy site tours
- Participation in TICE (This is Creative Enterprise) programme
- Durham Vocal Festival
- Middle and Secondary School's Showcase at Whitley Bay Playhouse
- Royal Northern Sinfonia (RNS Live) GCSE and A Level Set Works concert
- Opera North annual workshops and performances
- Sage Gateshead Music Hubs Gala Day
